a) Jyotirao Phule was born on 11 April 1827 at Katgun in Maharashtra. His parents were Govindarao and Chimnabai. He was married to Savitri Bai Phule. Jyotirao Phule was a great social reformer and educationist who worked for the upliftment of women and the lower castes in society.

He strongly believed that education could change society. In 1848, he opened the first girls school in Pune, which was a remarkable step during those days. Along with his wife Savitribai Phule, he fought against discrimination and social injustice throughout his life.

In recognition of his great service to society, he was honoured with the title "Mahatma". Jyothirao Phule passed away on 28th November 1890 in Pune. His efforts and contributions continue to inspire people even today.
