Discover and Learn Local Sites</p> <p>In discover and learn local sites, PM SHRI Schools will organize the students in small groups to explore the history of local sites in their locality using old photos, newspaper clippings, and letters and present their findings through creative ideas such as dressing and art drawings about the site.</p> <p>Objectives: To promote cultural and historical awareness, instil a sense of community and belonging, strengthen observation and inquiry and develop presentation skills</p>

In this event, Students will do registration as per the schedule prepared by the PM SHRI School. The registration can be done digitally, utilizing platforms such as Google Forms for convenience and efficiency. The PM SHRI School will appoint judges for the activities, ensuring fair and unbiased evaluation of the students' performances in all categories.
	Manthan Mandal (Debate Club) <i>Themes:</i> 1. <i>Viksit Bharat and its Contours</i> 2. <i>One Nation One Election.</i>	School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The PM SHRI School will organize a formal debate competition between different classes on topics like Viksit Bharat and One Nation, One Election. PM SHRI School will conduct a workshop on how to debate, fact-check, and present arguments. School will conduct small group discussions where students collaborate to present different viewpoints on selected topics, focusing on teamwork and collective learning. Junior students can be involved as audience. Have a 'Question & Answer' round to involve the audience. Create student committees to research debate topics

Introduce tools for social media (Instagram, Twitter, Facebook, Canva,). PM SHRI Schools will have students create and run social media campaigns on issues like Environment,

			<p>Sports, Education, Gender Equality, Democracy, Human rights, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A school-wide Hashtag Challenge will be conducted, where students promote social issues using creative hashtags. • Teachers support students in creating an action plan on posting images, videos, posters, etc. • PM SHRI Schools will host workshops on ethical social media use and cyber safety, promoting responsible digital behavior. • Track engagement metrics (likes, comments, shares) as part of their learning.
	Discover and Learn Local Sites	School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organise a research session where students use old photographs, clippings, and local stories to learn about local sites of significance. • Schools can invite a local historian or elder to share insights. • Visits to local sites of significance can be organised. • Students can form small groups to begin project work. • PM SHRI School to organize a mini-exhibition in school showcasing the presentations.

Invite local experts or education officers as panel judges. Record debates and share them online or through school websites for greater visibility.

Teachers can present awards for creativity, impact, and community engagement.
	Discover and Learn Local Sites	District	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conduct a district-level exhibition showcasing selected student projects. Consider adding local art, traditional dance, or drama to make the event more engaging.
