Step 1. Start with the Vocabulary section.


Step 2. Clarify the meaning and usage of each word to the students.

Step 4. Assist students in forming sentences using proper English. Emphasize correctness over complexity.

Word	Meaning	Example Sentence
Unique	Something very special and different	My cat is unique because she has different colored eyes.
Exciting	Making you feel happy and full of energy	The birthday party was exciting, and we played games.
Presentation	Showing and talking about something	In school, I did a presentation about my favorite book.
Showcase	Displaying the best and most important things	The museum will showcase beautiful paintings and sculptures.
Creativity	Making or thinking of new and interesting things	Drawing and coloring require a lot of creativity.

Word	Meaning	Example Sentence
Embarking	Starting or beginning something	We are embarking on a journey to explore the nearby forest.
Fascinating	Very interesting and making you curious	The butterfly garden is fascinating because of its colorful butterflies.
Landmarks	Special places that are easy to recognize	The tall mountain is a landmark that can be seen from far away.
Traditions	Things that people do the same way for a long time	Our family has a tradition of cooking together on holidays.
Assistance	Help or support from someone	The teacher offered assistance when the students had questions.

The next part focuses on Listening Skills and is Activity 1 out of 4.


- 1. Start by playing the audio using the icon below.




Audio Script: Activity 01



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


Audio Script: Activity 02



1.6 Activity 3 - Teacher's Conversation

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


Audio Script: Activity 03
