All the Regional Joint Directors of School Education, District Educational Officers and Additional Project Coordinators, Samagra Shiksha in the State are informed that the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, Government of India has stated that the discussion during the 50th PRAGATI meeting which was held under the chairpersonship of the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 31.12.2025 to review the implementation of PM SHRI scheme across States/UTs. During the meeting, it was emphasized to the States/UTs to nurture PM SHRI schools as exemplar institutions in alignment with the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, focusing on the 21 saturation points leading to enhanced learning outcomes.

As per the directions of the Government of India the following State Level reviewers deputed to districts, to visit the schools and to spend a full day in PM SHRI schools and carry out qualitative and quantitative assessments, with reports uploaded the same day on a central Gol digital platform.

The State level as "**State Reviewers**" to review the progress of activities under the scheme, particularly the development of student competencies and submit reports highlighting achievements, best practices and specific gaps, if any, identified during the visit on PM SHRI portal. A special facility has been created in the portal for submission of the visit reports by the State Reviewers. User manual demonstrating step-by-step process for using this facility in the PM SHRI portal is enclosed (**Annexure**) for kind reference. They are requested to complete the visit of all PM SHRI Schools in the concerned districts in the next 3 months and reports uploaded on the PM SHRI portal:

- a. Appointment of State-level officers as State Reviewers
- b. Creation of profile of State Reviewer on PM SHRI portal
- c. Assigning PM SHRI schools to be reviewed to the State Reviewers

Annexure

Instructions to the State reviewers for visit of PM SHRI schools:

All the State Reviewers are hereby instructed to visit the PM SHRI Schools allotted to them and conduct a comprehensive review of the implementation of PM SHRI activities.

The District Reviewers shall spend a full day in the allotted PM SHRI School and thoroughly observe the implementation of all components relating to the PM SHRI Scheme with special focus on NEP-2020 practices, student competencies, academic standards, infrastructure, digital initiatives and school governance.

Before Visit:

1. Communicate the inspection format to all PM SHRI schools
2. Information will be given to the school Heads an advance about inspection
3. Ensure that your name is added as a Reviewer in the PM SHRI Inspection Portal by the State Nodal Officer.
4. Log in to the PM SHRI Inspection Portal using your registered mobile number and OTP.
5. After login, verify the list of PM SHRI Schools allotted to you in the portal.
6. Open the online inspection form and review all the indicators/checkpoints mentioned in the portal before visiting the school.
7. Plan the visit to the allotted PM SHRI School and ensure proper inspection of all PM SHRI components during the visit.
8. Each reviewer shall cover 3 to 4 schools per day and complete inspections of all schools twice within a period of 3 months.

During Visit:

1. Conduct the inspection in a positive manner and appreciate the best practices implemented by the school.
2. Interact with the Headmaster/Principal, teachers, students, and School Management Committee (SMC) members.
3. Observe classroom teaching, student participation, learning practices, and school activities.
4. Verify the infrastructure, ICT/CCL Labs, libraries, laboratories, sanitation, drinking water, and other facilities available in the school as per the prescribed format.
5. Examine the implementation of FLN activities, inclusive education, CPD activities, school website, and other PM SHRI components.
6. Record observations carefully in the prescribed format provided by the State.
7. Encourage the school to showcase the best practices implemented in the school.
8. Collect the filled-in formats from the HeadMasters after completion of the visit.
9. Identify the gaps and suggest immediate rectification measures.
10. The State has provided formats covering all components. If any component is missing, or if the Headmasters are unaware or have filled the formats incorrectly, guide them to fill the gaps correctly.
11. Encourage the Headmasters to improve their scores by effectively showcasing their best practices.

12. Collect documentation of the best practices implemented in the school.

After the Visit:

1. Log in to the PM SHRI Inspection Portal during/after the school visit.
2. Record observations carefully in the online inspection form available in the PM SHRI Portal.
3. Fill in all the required details in the PM SHRI Inspection Portal and submit the inspection report online on the same day without fail.
4. Advise the Headmasters to rectify the identified defects and ensure 100% compliance during the next visit.
5. Ensure completion of inspections in all schools by the team within a period of 3 months.
6. Update the identified defects and action points in the online portal.

The objective is to ensure mandatory visits to all PM SHRI Schools in the State by designated State Reviewers and timely (3 months) submission of inspection reports through the portal.

SNO Login:

1. State Nodal Officers (SNOs) can create user accounts for officials who will conduct school visits.
2. While creating users, details such as Name, Mobile Number, Email ID, etc., need to be entered.
3. SNOs can assign specific PM SHRI Schools to the respective users.

User Login & Inspection Process:

1. Users can log in using their phone number and OTP.
2. The list of assigned schools will be displayed in their logins.
3. After visiting a school, the user can select the respective school, fill in the required questionnaires/inspection details, and submit the report online.
4. These users are State Reviewers.
