

TOEFL Junior Level - Day wise Practice sheets Classes : 8 & 9

Instructions:

1. Weekly three classes (on every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday) are allotted for TOEFL as per academic calendar - 2023-24.
2. Day wise practice sheets are prepared.
3. Each Practice sheet consists of three parts – Reading, Language forms and Listening.
4. Allot 20 min. for reading and language forms. 20 min for Listening practice in your TOEFL period.
5. Display the reading sheet on IFPs/Smart TV and make students note down and answer the questions.
6. For listening play the audio clip on IFPs/Smart TV for five times continuously and ask the children to listen carefully.
7. Display the listening sheet on IFPs/Smart TV. Make the students write their options in their note books.
8. The teacher has to check their note books regularly.
9. Keep your observation and evaluation recorded.



The simple past tense is used to describe the action that happened in the past.

Sentence	Formula & Examples
Positive	<i>[Subject + V2 + object]</i>
	She got up early in the morning.
Negative	<i>[Subject + did + not + V1 + object]</i>
	She didn't get up early in the morning.
Question	<i>[Did + subject + V1 + object + ?]</i>
	Did she get up early in the morning?
Wh- Questions	<i>[Wh + Did + subject + V1 + object + ?]</i>
	Why did she get up early in the morning?
